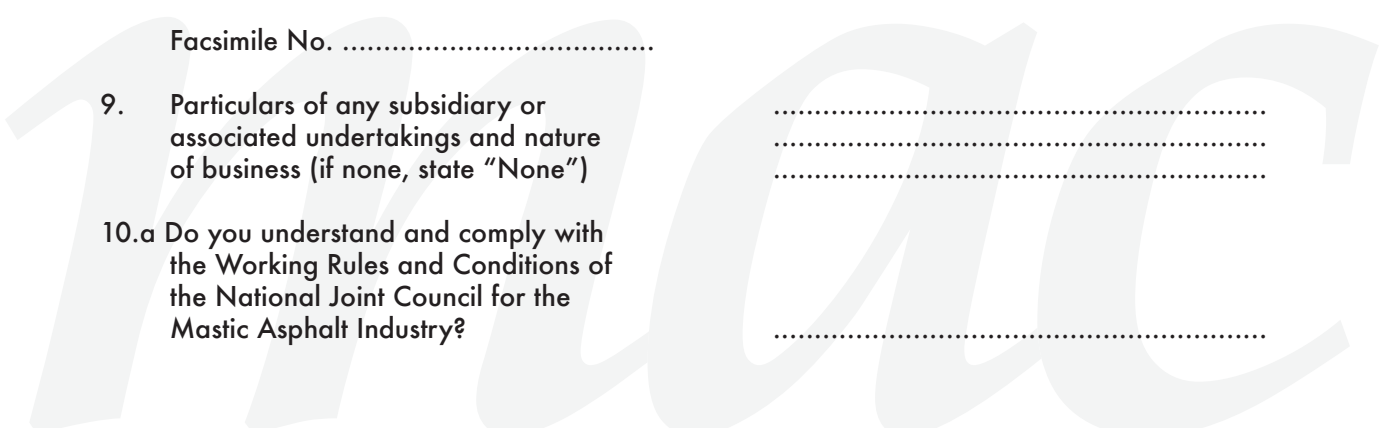

DECLARATION

Agreement dated
between the Mastic Asphalt Council Ltd (hereinafter called "the Council") and
(hereinafter called "the Company") of

Now whereas the Company on being a Member of the Council amongst whose objects
are the maintenance of the highest quality material and workmanship in the mastic asphalt
industry, agrees:

- 1. To promote only the grades of mastic asphalt recommended in the Council's specifications
or the grades for special applications or such proprietary-named materials as have been
notified to and approved by the Council for specific applications, such approval not being
unreasonably withheld. This shall not apply to new materials being used experimentally.
2. To offer by tender or by quotation for contracting work only such grades of mastic asphalt as
are defined in clause (3).
3. To supply and/or to lay in contracting work only such grades of mastic asphalt as are defined
in clause (1) and in particular scrupulously to refrain from the use of admixtures of differing
grades of mastic asphalt or to reduce the thickness or number of coats proper to the applica-
tion with a view to avoidance of compliance with the specification tendered for or laid down.
4. To maintain an organisation which allows for the proper and adequate supervision at all
times of every contract undertaken, and strictly to adhere to the Codes of Practice as defined
by the British Standards Institution covering the application of mastic asphalt or, in certain
cases where necessary, to the practices defined in the Council's technical literature.
5. To support and strictly abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Council and the Working
Rules and Conditions and Apprenticeship Scheme of the National Joint Council for the Mastic
Asphalt Industry.
